

North West Legislature Speaker to Host BASADI RE AGA SETSHABA Outreach Programme in Seshibetswe in Moses Kotane Municipality

On Wednesday, 08 August 2018, the Speaker of North West Provincial Legislature, Hon. Sussana Dantjie will engage women in politics and young women in arts culture through **Basadi Re Aga Setshaba** outreach programme under the theme *“Celebrating the Legacy of Mama Albertina Sisulu”* in Seshibetswe Community Hall near Madikwe in Moses Kotane Local Municipality at 10h00.

The event aims to profile women’ businesses and political careers; achieve public participation in government structures; educate women of Bokone Bophirima on the role and responsibility of the Legislature as mandated by the Constitution, Act 108 of 1996; to enhance oversight function of the Legislature; and profile its activities.
